Transforming Graduate Admissions Seed Grant

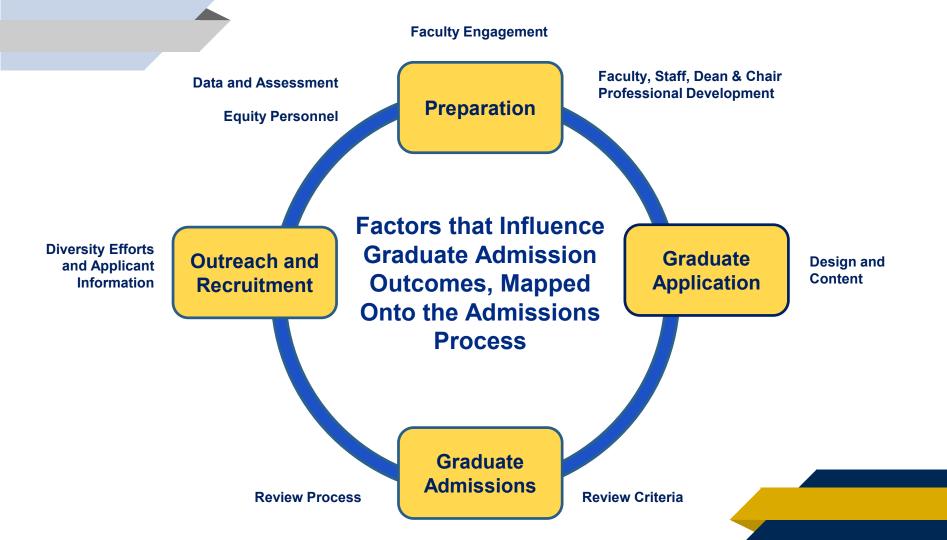
- Year long project
